A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to modify provisions relating to kidnapping, sexual abuse, and illicit sexual conduct with respect to minors.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. KIDNAPPING; SEXUAL ABUSE; ILLICIT SEXUAL
- 4 CONDUCT WITH RESPECT TO MINORS.
- 5 (a) In General.—Part I of title 18, United States
- 6 Code, is amended—
- 7 (1) in section 1201—

1	(A) in subsection (a), in the matter pre-
2	ceding paragraph (1), by inserting "obtains by
3	defrauding or deceiving any person," after "ab-
4	ducts,";
5	(B) in subsection (b), by inserting "ob-

10	"(2) Defense.—For an offense described in
11	this subsection involving a victim who has not at-

15	of the evidence that the offender reasonably believed
16	that the victim had attained the age of 16 years.";

12	age of 16 years, with an intent to abuse, humiliate,
13	harass, degrade, or arouse or gratify the sexual de-
14	sire of any person, or attempt to do so, if to do so
15	would violate subsection (a), (b), or (c) of this sec-
16	tion, section 2241, or section 2242 had such inten-
17	tional touching been a sexual act.
18	"(2) Penalty.—Any person who violates para-
19	graph (1) shall be fined under this title, imprisoned
20	as provided in the applicable provision of law de-
21	scribed in that paragraph, or both."; and
