Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting \$987,000 in funding for the Fulshear Police Department Communication Technology Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The Fulshear Police Department, located at 6639 W Cross Creek Bend Ln, Fulshear, Texas, 77441. The funding would be used for the procurement of communication technology for various emergency assets within the department. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide the Fulshear Police with an emergency response trailer for a mobile command post for dispatchers and commanders; a mobile communications trailer to provide redundant internet and radio coverage to a large area; smaller portable emergency communications kits; and video surveillance trailers to provide surveillance coverage and deterrence to high crime areas. This equipment would ensure that the Fulshear Police Department has redundancy in all capabilities needed to respond to emergency and natural disaster situations, in addition to everyday duties and responsibilities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
