I am requesting funding for the MyCHN Pearland Imaging Expansion Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Stephen F. Austin Community Health Center, dba Community Health Network (MyCHN), located at 1346 Broadway Street Suite 100, Pearland, Texas 77581. The funding would be used for the acquisition of essential equipment, including CT, MRI, PET/CT, cardiac imaging, and digital radiography, to improve access to timely, high-quality diagnostic care. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project will expand access to advanced diagnostic imaging services for residents of Texas' 22nd Congressional District, particularly for low-income, uninsured, and medically underserved populations. By increasing imaging capacity, patients will have timely access to essential diagnostic tools that enable providers to detect conditions such as cancer, cardiovascular disease, and other serious illnesses earlier in the disease process. Early detection and preventive care are among the most effective ways to improve health outcomes while reducing the overall cost of healthcare. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
