I am requesting \$1,500,000 for a Feasibility Study for the Port of Palacios Channel Deepening and Widening Feasibility Study. The entity to receive these funds is the US Army Corps of Engineers.

The Port of Palacios needs to expand its current footprint to meet the future needs of the maritime industry. The first part of this expansion is to perform a study which would deepen and widen the Palacios Channel. The Palacios Channel is currently constrained at 14' deep and 125' wide, which limits us to the types of vessels it is able to get in and out of the Port. Deepening and widening the Palacios Channel would help the Port facilitate projects which provide regional economic growth as well as support the State of Texas and the United States.
